**Concept note**

The lecture consists of three main parts.

In the first part, I will present the challenges faced by traditional concepts and forms of education in the AI era, particularly from the perspective of human learning and knowledge construction. Highlighting that another wave of the industrial-technical revolution will inevitably force a reconsideration of the social function of schools. New opportunities may open for every learner that were previously inaccessible.

In the second part of the presentation, I will explore the achievements of the sociocultural and cooperative educational discourse in the context of learning and social interactions, drawing on decades of practices built on collaborative learning communities. I will connect this with the proposed next stage in education based on AI-driven learning, bringing in research findings from the field of educational science.

The third part of the lecture will focus on leadership approaches in school communities, discussing the community of learners, the community of practice, and the cooperative learning paradigm as the three pillars. These three approaches can help educational leaders collaboratively rethink the role of schools in social space and operation, involving not only colleagues, students, parents, and school partners but also the local, regional, national, and international environment of the school.
